GENERAL INFORMATION

BIG BUBBLE is a concentrated bubble gum fragrance designed to be added to tank mixes that contain chemicals or other ingredients that have an objectionable odor. As a masking agent, this product will mask foul odors generated during spray applications without affecting the efficacy of the active ingredients being applied.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Start with 1 - 3 ounces of BIG BUBBLE per gallon of liquid, or 4 pounds of wettable powder chemicals with objectionable odor. Fragrance intensity will vary with different chemicals. If additional masking is desired, slowly increase until satisfactory masking has been obtained.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container only. Do not add anything to the container. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not store near fire, flame or other potential sources of ignition. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of this product.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of
